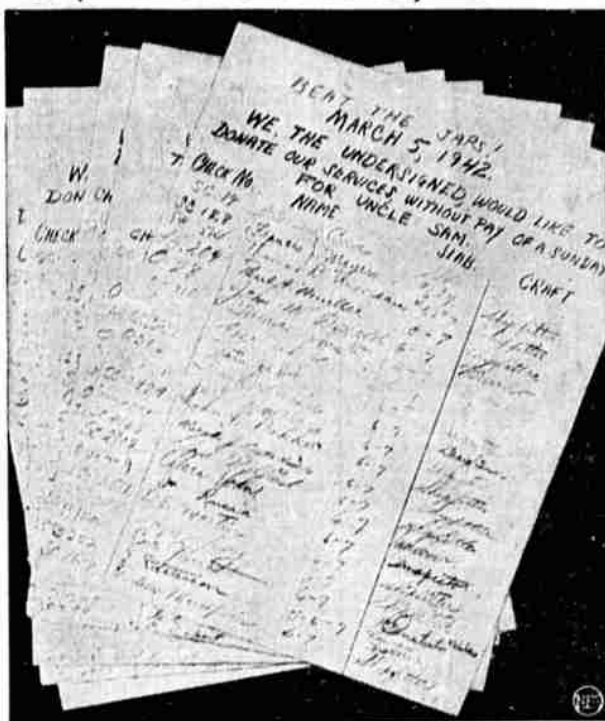
BAR EXAMS
