

PLANS SHAPED FOR CONTROL OF 'HOPPERS'

Those annual pests, the grasshoppers, seem to get along all right even without copying their distant cousins, the ants. There is a nice fat crop of them expected out of their eggs if this warm weather continues.

C. A. Henderson, Klamath county agricultural agent, made a trip to the Upper Klamath marsh on the Silver Lake road Tuesday afternoon. Henderson reported there were two areas in which a good crop of the devastating insects could be expected, on the Upper Klamath marsh and at the head of Williamson river.

Grasshoppers will probably be less in evidence this year than in the past due to the war which has been waged against them for many seasons. As soon as they start hatching, the infested areas will be given a good dusting of dinitro-cresol, a dust found most effective in killing the young. Some poison will be used in the areas as well, Henderson stated.

The eggs are pretty much in the winter state, the county agent observed, but one week of warm weather should bring them out in force.

Fastidious Parrot Gets Sugar Card To Quiet Temper

ADRIAN, Mich., May 21 (AP)—Mrs. John Johnston has obtained a sugar rationing card for her parrot, a fastidious parrot, after explaining to a rationing board that it was necessary for both the family's peace of mind and the bird's health.

With polly cut down on its sugar, its disposition went badly sour and the Johnston farm home five miles northwest of here became upset.

"Things have been 'on edge,'" Mrs. Johnston said.

The bird's peculiarities include a stern dislike for cookies, candy and water but insistence on coffee three times daily—with sugar.

The rationing board granted polly a card for one pound of sugar a month under the "pet provision" of the rationing order.

"Whereas, the entire proceeds of the sale of buddy poppies are devoted to relief and assistance of disabled and needy veterans and their families, to the welfare and assistance of the men in the armed forces of our country to-day and to the support and maintenance of the VFW national home for widows and orphans of deceased veterans, these objectives deserving the full support and assistance of all,

"NOW THEREFORE, I, John H. Houston, Mayor of the city of Klamath Falls, Ore., do hereby proclaim that Saturday, May 23, be observed as Buddy Poppy day and respectfully urge that all citizens of this community purchase a buddy poppy on that day, contribute generously to this worthy cause, and thus honor the dead by helping the living."

OAKLAND, Calif., May 21 (AP)—J. C. Penney company filed a \$6010 libel suit Wednesday in superior court against local 1265 of the Department and Specialty Store Employees' union (AFL), and several Alameda county labor officials.

The defendants, it was charged, have circulated handbills asserting the store was non-union and urging customers to patronize other stores.

The company said its old union contract was cancelled June 1, 1941, and it has received no new proposition for a collective bargaining agreement since.
