WHEAT PRICES OFF AFTER RALLY MOVE CHICAGO, June 2 (AP)—After gaining as much as a cent a bushel in early trading, wheat futures again turned reactionary and prices slumped more than a cent a bushel today.

Just before the final gong, July wheat sold at \$1.15 1/2, establishing another new seasonal low. All deliveries of rye also broke sharply into new low ground for the season.

The weakness of grains and soybeans was attributed to a downturn of around \$2 a bale in cotton. Prices for wheat and rye touched off stop loss selling.
