Regular league play will be renewed this weekend in the Oregon-California loop after the Memorial day open date last week with the two leaders, Klamath Falls and Dorris, facing each other at the Pelicans' Recreation park in a crucial early-season two-game series that may decide the first-half title. The last-place Grants Pass Marauders and Medford's Craters meanwhile will be battling in a brace of contests in the valley.

Interest in the Pelican-Lumberjack tilt likely will reach the peak by the time the first game of the series, scheduled for 6:30 p. m. Saturday evening, gets underway at the local field. Both managers, Red Tolbert of the Californians and Ernie Bishop of the Klamathas, are determined to annex both engagements and take over the top rung in the standings.

Clyde Carlstrom, veteran of Klamath basin teams and winner of eight games for the Klamath Oregon State league entrant last year, doubtless will be Manager Tolbert's choice for the mound assignment in the Saturday fracas with either Leo Soran or Frank Van Driesche slated to do the pitching for the Pelicans.

Manager Bishop, who piloted the 1941 Pelicans to second place in the fast state circuit last season, probably will call upon Virg Haynes to do the twirling in the Sunday meeting with a southpaw named Snyder as Tolbert's likely starting hurler.

Both clubs are striving to line up additional strength for the series. Principal worry of the Klamath leader is the lack of hard-hitting outfielders while the Lumberjacks are reportedly seeking a couple of infielders.

Regardless of the outcome, the two games at Recreation field are due to be full of action with both teams shooting for a double win. Team officers are expecting a large audience at both contests. The Sunday affair is billed to start at 1:30 p. m.

Portland Rallies But Loses in 11 Innings, 3-2; Angels Beat Oaks, 5-4

San Diego, the Pacific Coast league team overlooked by most experts at the opening of the baseball season, bobbed up in second place, a full game ahead of Sacramento after defeating Portland, 3 to 2, in 11 innings last night.

The Solons helped the Padres into the runner-up spot behind Los Angeles by dropping a game to Seattle in the ninth inning when Rainier batsmen blasted Blix Donnelly for four hits and five runs to break a tie and win, 6 to 1.

At San Diego, Padre manager, Cedric Durst said his club is prepared to shift from night to a twilight or day schedule if civilian defense officials rule that Lane field lights violate coastal dim-out orders.

Portland came from behind to score two runs in the ninth and force last night's game into extra innings in what may have been the last night game at the Padre park which is located near the waters of San Diego bay.

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Ernie Slips, Wins, But Allows Eight

Yanks Victors, 4-1; A's Halt Tigers, 5-1; Braves Near Second on 4-3 Win

Ernie Bonham, the undefeated right-handed pitching star of the New York Yankees, is getting too good for his own good. Jumbo won his eighth straight game yesterday, 4-1, at the expense of the Chicago White Sox. He kept eight hits scattered,

walked only two, and would have had a shutout except for a homer by Joe Kuhel in the seventh.

This pitching almost certainly would have satisfied the supporters of any other hurler in the majors, but the onlookers at Yankee Stadium were quick to size it up as one of Bonham's poorest performances of the season.

In the first place it wasn't a shutout. The big fellow had administered four of these in his first seven starts and by the time he had laid six goose-eggs end to end yesterday some of the boys figured he should have had another.

The Philadelphia Athletics brought the Detroit Tigers to a sudden stop with a 5-1 decision on Jack Knott's six-hit hurling. The A's were held to seven safeties themselves, but nicked Hal White for three runs in the fifth inning to sew up the game.

The St. Louis Browns routed Sid Hudson with an eight-run assault in the second inning and went on to whip Washington, 9-5, dropping the Senators into the American league cellar.

In the National league the Pittsburgh Pirates received a reprieve from the weather man providing time to recover from the 17-2 shelling they received the day before the Brooklyn Dodgers.

Meanwhile the Boston Braves moved a game closer to the second-place Cardinals by capturing a 4-3 twilight struggle at St. Louis.

Frank (Rube) Melton pitched and batted the Phils to a 2-1 ten-inning triumph over the Cincinnati Reds in a night game. He spaced six hits and doubled home the winning run.

Glen Rupp, whose job as Chicago Cubs' first baseman has been threatened by the purchase of Jimmy Foxx, belted a home run with the bases full in the first inning to lead Chicago to a 6 to 2 triumph over the New York Giants. The blow finished Tom Sunkel, who had loaded the sacks with three walks. Claude Passeau marked up his eighth mound victory for the Cubs, although touched for eight hits, three by Willard Marshall.

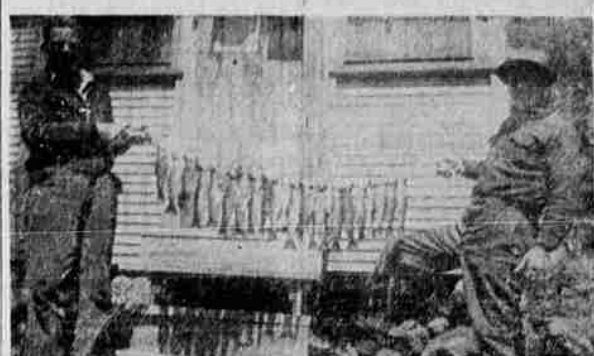

Foxx, Cavarretta Happy, But Russell May Lose Job

CHICAGO, June 4 (AP)—Jim Foxx has joined the Chicago Cubs presumably to take over the first base job, and Phil Cavarretta who used to hold down that post is crowing contentedly that he's now an outfielder. But for Glen (Rip) Russell, it's a more serious matter. He's dangerously close to losing his place as a regular.

So concerned has Russell been that in the two games since the Cubs bought Foxx from the Boston Red Sox he has busted out a home run a day, yesterday's against the New York Giants coming with the bases filled.

Should Foxx, incapacitated by a broken rib, be delegated to serve as more than a pinch hitter, and take command of first base, he would be the fourth to work that sack for the Cubs this year.

In addition to Cavarretta and Russell, the Cubs have used Ellsworth (Babe) Dahlgren there. A few weeks ago, they sold Dahlgren to the St. Louis Browns only to have him bounce when the Browns balked at the written bill of sale. Subsequently, Dahlgren was sold to Brooklyn.

The arrival of Foxx yesterday was a festive occasion. After conferring with General Manager James Gallagher, the whole Cub clan gathered in the dressing room so the younger Chicagoans (many in their early twenties) could gaze on this mighty veteran of 35 years.

Lindsay, billed as Canadian bantamweight champion, carried the fight to Salica throughout but the champ's greater experience told as he continually made the Vancouver battler miss completely.

The bout was fast from beginning to end with both fighters mixing it up in toe to toe slug-fests several times.

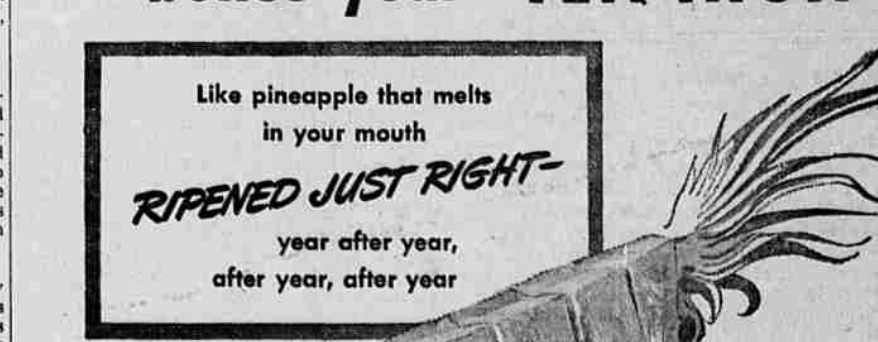
