CHICAGO, June 13 (AP)—Wheat prices were up almost a cent a bushel and rye more than a cent at times today but other grains lagged behind and, thus, tended to check the bread cereal upturn.

Scattered short covering and mill buying, stimulated partly by government moves to hold 1943 acreage to the minimum permitted by law and to increase farm and country storage space for the crop now coming to market, strengthened wheat as well as rye.

Wheat closed unchanged to 1c higher, compared with yesterday, July \$1.18 1/2, September \$1.21 1/2; corn unchanged to 1c up, July 86 1/2-86c, September 88 1/2-88c; oats 1-1c higher; soybeans 1-1c higher; rye 1-1c higher.
