

# BIO, PIRC AGREE ON NEW METHOD OF SETTLEMENT

A new method for handling issues arising under the new CIO-Pine Industrial Relations committee labor agreement, agreed upon during recent union-employer negotiations and termed a workable, reasonable solution by representatives of both factions, was revealed today.

The method was proposed by the PIRC in a meeting with the union on May 20 and formally accepted in a later session.

It provides that all disputes be settled, if possible, between each employer and his employees' plant committee. If agreement cannot be reached the dispute shall be referred, if either side requests it, to the PIRC and the Klamath basin district council of the CIO Industrial Council of workers of America for handling.

Written request for PIRC and council handling must be made within five days of final disagreement.

Both the PIRC and the district council, will thereupon be authorized, through representatives each may designate, to seek an amicable settlement.

The agreement provides that normal operation shall not be interfered with and no strike, lockout or other stoppage shall be permissible until seven days after either the PIRC or the district council has given written notice to the disputants that they are unable to agree upon a settlement.

## These Simple Recipes Coax Appetites in Hot Weather

Eggs, beef liver and vegetables are essential foods, we all know. But we like them to taste good. Here are a few simple recipes to coax the summer appetite into eating the proper foods.

### Spanish Eggs (Serves 4 to 5)

One garlic clove, 1 large tomato, 1 tablespoon butter, 6 eggs, 1 teaspoon salt, 1 teaspoon pepper.

Rub garlic clove over inside of frying pan. Pare tomato and cut

into small pieces. Melt butter in frying pan, add tomato and cook 5 minutes. Beat eggs well and add to tomatoes. Add seasoning. Cook slowly, stirring constantly. Until eggs are done. Serve on rounds of thin buttered toast.

### Liver Loaf (Serves 4 to 6)

One pound beef liver, 1 cup stock, 2 small white onions, 1 pound pork sausage, 1 cup cracker crumbs, 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce, 1 tablespoon lemon juice, 1 tablespoon salt, 1 teaspoon pepper, 1 teaspoon celery

salt, 2 eggs, 2 slices bacon. Place liver in saucepan and add enough hot water to cover. Simmer gently for 5 minutes. Drain liver and save 1 cup of liver

Worcestershire sauce, lemon juice, salt, pepper, celery salt and eggs and mix well. Place in greased loaf pan and top with bacon. Bake in moderate oven (350 Deg. F.) 45 minutes. Serve hot or cold.

### MENU BREAKFAST: Stewed blackberries, oatmeal, toast, coffee, milk.

LUNCHEON: Spanish eggs on toast rounds, honeydew melon with lemons, iced tea, milk.

DINNER: Cold sliced liver loaf, sliced tomatoes and chives, creamed potatoes, warm rolls, raspberries and cream, corn syrup cookies, iced coffee, milk.

## Girls' Chances For Marriage Take a Nosedive

DALLAS, Tex., July 2 (AP)—A girl's chances of getting married has been greatly lessened by the war, says Dr. H. L. Pritchett, head of Southern Methodist university's sociology department.

He estimated that there are now 800,000 to 850,000 unmarried women between 40 and 45 in the United States, left without husbands because of the last war. The present conflict will leave an even greater number of single women, the sociologist predicted because of the nature of casualties, which include a greater per-

centage of fatalities than heretofore. The length of the war, too, will have its effect on marriages. Men returning from the last war married girls who had been in high school when the soldiers left home. The age divergence in marriages then was 4½ years, compared to an average divergence of about two years.

### KIDNEY BEANS WITH SPARERIBS

1 1/2 lbs. spareribs cut in 3-rib pieces 1 1/4 cups meat stock  
2 tbsp. shortening 3/4 cup finely chopped carrots  
1/4 cup finely chopped onion 1/2 tsp. thyme  
1/4 tsp. finely chopped garlic 2 cups cooked kidney beans

Brown spareribs in hot shortening in heavy frying pan. Add onion and garlic; cook about 5 minutes, stirring frequently. Place spareribs in casserole. Combine meat stock (or 8 bouillon cubes dissolved in 1 1/4 cups boiling water), seasonings, and beans; pour over spareribs; cover. Bake in slow oven (325° F.) about 1 hour or until spareribs are tender. Serves 6. (Double recipe serves 12.)
