

**Dies Apologizes For Accusation Of Vaughan**

WASHINGTON, July 10 (AP)—Chairman Dies (D-Tex.) of the house committee investigating un-American activities publicly apologized Thursday for having

accused David B. Vaughan, board of economic warfare executive, of being "a sponsor of the American League for Peace and Democracy." The accusation, Dies said in a statement inserted in the Congressional Record, was made "in a letter written by me on March 28, 1942," to Vice President Wal-

**Ingersoll Stays In Class 1-A**

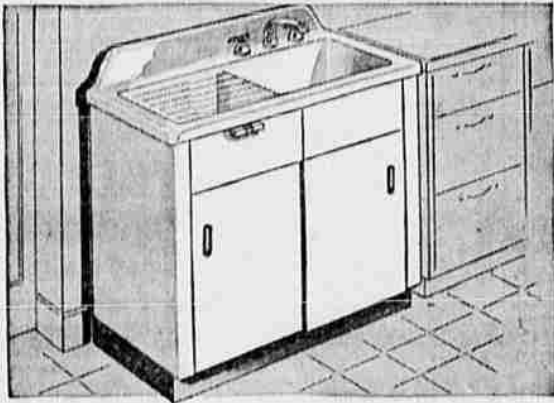
