Emilie Nofke, 22, Burns to Death In Plane Crash

MILES CITY, Mont., July 29 (P)—Trapped in the wreckage of a plane which crashed in Graveyard creek valley, Emilie Nofke, 22, of Tacoma, Wash., burned to death yesterday.

The plane, one of six small privately-owned craft being flown from Tacoma to Aberdeen, S. D., smashed against a steep hill when Miss Nofke made a forced landing.

Miss Nofke was a widely known Tacoma aviatrix. She had been a ground school instructor in the CAA program at Pasco and Yakima, Wash., and had operated an aviation ground school at Boeing field, Seattle. More recently, she worked as a mechanic at McChord field near Tacoma.

PORTLAND, July 29 (P)—The last scheduled meeting of the state board of higher education before September 9 was ad-

President Willard L. Marks declined following the meeting to comment on the situation further than to say that progress is being made. Asked whether a special meeting would be called, he declined to add further to his

first statement. It was apparent that the board members had held one or more discussions on the matter this time, but whether any tentative agreement had been reached was not revealed.

There has been no announcement of the names of candidates. The position has been vacant since the resignation last September of Frank L. Ballard, whose health broke several

months after he took over the presidency in July 1940.

Dr. F. A. Gillfillan, dean of the school of science, served during President Ballard's illness as head of an administrative committee and was appointed acting president last September on President Ballard's resignation.
