

Evil-visaged, bespectacled, balding Gen, Hideki Tojo, premier of Japan since last October, is now virtually unchallenged as dictator, with his emperor a restrained figurehead and only military associates remaining in his cabinet. Tojo has behind him many victories by his little yellow warriors in the Asiatic jungles, but also is beset by a growing number of defeats like the sinkings of his warships in the Pacific and the loss of the southern solomons.
