WHEAT

CHICAGO, Oct. 19 (AP) - Losses ranging from fractions to about a cent a bushel were posted in the grain and soybeans futures trade at times today but the market showed enough recovery power to check the decline and permit small rallies frequently. Hedging sales accounted for some of the weakness, particularly in corn, which was affected by expanding harvest operations. Soybeans reflected lack of elevator or merchandise buying interest in view of the government price guarantee and the embargo on shipments to this market. Failure of flour business to revive accounted for continued lagging trade in wheat, with uncertainty regarding the flour ceiling an unsettling market factor.

Wheat closed unchanged to 1 lower compared with Saturday, December 13, 1941, May 1, 1942, 1-1; corn 1-1 lower, December 80, May 84; oats 1-1 down; rye 1-1 lower; soybeans 1-1 lower.
