LEGAL NOTICE: National Forest Timber For Sale: Sealed bids will be received by the Forest Supervisor, Medford, Oregon, up to and not later than 9 a. m. October 27, 1942, for 3,000,000 feet B.M., more or less, of live and dead Douglas-fir timber; and an unestimated amount of ponderosa pine, sugar pine, white fir, hemlock and other species of saw timber to be cut at the option of the purchaser, to be marked for cutting within an area embracing about 4,000 acres in Sections 18 and 19, Township 36 South, Range 6 East; and Sections 13, 14, 24, 25, 26 and 36, Township 36 South, Range 5 East, W. M. Rogue River National Forest, Oregon. No bid of less than \$3.05 per M feet for Douglas-fir, \$6.40 per M feet for ponderosa pine and sugar pine, \$1.90 per M feet for white fir and hemlock, and \$1.00 per M feet for other species will be considered. In determining the high bid, the rate for Douglas-fir only will be considered. In addition to the prices bid for the stumpage, a cooperative deposit of \$0.60 per M feet B.M. to be used by the Forest Service for paying the cost of slash disposal, for the total cut of timber under the terms of the agreement, will be required. \$3,850 must be deposited with each bid, to be applied on the purchase price, refunded, or retained in part as liquidated damages, according to conditions of sale. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. Before bids are submitted, full information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale, and submission of bids should be obtained from the Forest Supervisor, Medford, Oregon. O. 16-31 - No. 137.
