Pacific time, November 20, 1942, for the purchase of merchantable timber on a tract within the Klamath Indian Reservation, Oregon, described as the South Calimus Timber Unit. The Unit includes about 20, 910 timbered acres with an estimated cut of 149,000,000 feet B. M., of ponderosa and sugar pines, of which about 108,000 feet of ponderosa pine stands on about 45 timbered acres of allotted lands, for which separate approved contracts must afterward be made with allottees desiring to sell, and on terms similar to the contract for the unallotted timber. Each bid must state the price per thousand and feet B. M., Scribner Decimal C Log Scale, that will be paid for timber cut and scaled prior to March 31, 1943. Prices subsequent to that date are to be fixed by the Secretary of the Interior. No bid will be considered for less than \$4.75 per thousand feet B. M. for ponderosa and sugar pines, \$1.50 for Douglas fir and incense cedar, and \$0.75 for other species. Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check in the amount of \$22,000 on a solvent National Bank, payable to the Special Disbursing Agent, Klamath Indian Agency, Oregon. The deposit will be returned to unsuccessful bidders. The deposit of the successful bidder will be applied as part of the purchase price against timber actually cut on this Unit only, or retained as liquidated damages if the bidder shall not execute contract and furnish satisfactory bond for \$30,000 within 60 days from acceptance of his bid.
