 NEW YORK, Nov. 23 (AP)—More good war news, especially the big Russian offensive at Stalingrad, served to lower stocks with an armament rating today but many market leaders in the peace division did little more than display mild resistance. Transfers were around 600,000 shares.  
 Both Alaska Juneau and Dome mines touched new highs for the year in the forepart of the session but failed to follow through. Homestake was a shade ahead most of the time, as were North American, J. I. Case, Johns-Manville and Sears Roebuck. International Telephone held in the vicinity of Saturday's final quotation.
