HOLIDAY WAS TOO MUCH FOR STOCK MARKET

NEW YORK, Nov. 27 (AP)—It may have been too much turkey dinner Thursday but both the buying and selling appetite in today's stock market displayed signs of satiation and minor irregularity ruled throughout a slow session.

The list was highly selective from the start and, with the ticker tape frequently halting, plus marks had a trifle the best of the argument near the close. Industrials were among the principal gainers. Rails and steels did nothing the greater part of the time and numerous leaders held at their final pre-holiday levels. Transfers were around 500,000 shares.

In the face of indifferent dealings, new highs for the year were posted for Coca-Cola, Eastman Kodak, International Harvester and Montgomery Ward.

Given an occasional lift were American Airlines, Eastern Air Lines, United Air Lines, U. S. Rubber, Chrysler, J. I. Case, American Telephone, Western Union, International Telephone, DuPont, American Can, Westinghouse, Johns-Manville and U. S. Gypsum.

In the hesitant division were Southern Pacific, Pennsylvania, Yellow Truck, Anaconda, Kennecott, Phelps Dodge, International Nickel, Douglas Aircraft and Phelps Dodge. Bonds steadied.
