

MARITIME UNION THREATENS STRIKE

PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 12 (AP)—Two seamen's unions threatened a strike today to keep the CIO National Maritime Union from getting a start on the Pacific coast.

Officials of the AFL Sailors' Union of the Pacific and the CIO Marine Cooks and Stewards

union said the maritime commission plans to man a Portland-built Liberty freighter with men from the NMU, the east coast CIO Sailors' union.

They said they would picket the ship if NMU men are hired, and would call for a strike vote of all west coast members.

The unions' joint announcement said hiring of NMU members would violate a contract agreed upon by the Grace line, to which the ship is to be delivered.

MRS. JESTER WILL RECRUIT WAACS HERE

Mrs. C. Jester has been placed in charge of recruiting for the WAACs in Klamath Falls, and will carry on the effort with the support of the American Legion auxiliary.

Mrs. Jester has been ill for several days since her appointment, but expects soon to start an active recruiting program. Interested persons can now get in touch with her at her home telephone, dial 7482. She will announce shortly where she can be personally interviewed.

Recent manpower changes have not altered in any way the recruiting for the women's army auxiliary corps and enlistment will definitely continue, according to Colonel J. J. Fulmer, commander of the Oregon recruiting and induction district.

Practical Appeal
Congressional authorization for the expansion of the women's army has created a demand for women with and without vocational experience. Colonel Fulmer said that applicants need no longer present evidence of specific educational background, however, a mental alertness examination will be given to determine the applicants aptitude for service.

The colonel called attention to the practical as well as the patriotic appeal of the WAAC. Women soldiers now receive the same pay as the regular army. An auxiliary, which corresponds to an army private, receives \$30 a month while as a first leader equal to a first sergeant, she will receive \$138. With quarters, board, uniforms, and medical care furnished this liberal pay rate leaves the average WAAC well "supplied" with spending money.

Women between the ages of 21 to 44 inclusive, of good moral character, and in good physical condition are urged to consider the opportunity for serving America offered by the women's army auxiliary corps. KF MOTORISTS ADVISED TO SWITCH TIRES

The city traffic safety council today issued a statement urging Klamath motorists to switch the tires on their cars to equalize wear.

The council listed the following reasons:

1. Right hand tires rub the curb more often, and consequently get more abuse.
2. Right hand tires run closer to the gutter, where broken glass, nails and sharp stones accumulate.
3. Right hand tires frequently ride the rough edge of the pavement, off the shoulder and back again.
4. Graded roads throw more weight on the right hand tires.

So, the council suggests, shift tires from side to side, and from front to back as well, and make frequent use of the spare. "The tires will last longer and you'll be safer," the council added.

AFL Union Opens Membership to Negroes in Yards

PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 12 (AP)—Charles Merritt, a spokesman for negro shipyard workers in the Portland-Vancouver area, said yesterday that the AFL Boilermakers' union had opened membership to negroes.

He said union officials indicated other shipyard unions would follow suit. Merritt said the unions' policy resulted from a recent conference of federal, shipyard and union officials on charges, made by the 200 negro shipyard employees, of racial discrimination.
