U OF O WILL TRAIN 200 IN METEOROLOGY

The University of Oregon has just qualified for training cadets in meteorology and 200 students can take this work under army instruction. It was reported by State Senator Marshall Cornett Tuesday.

Senator Cornett said that Major T. R. Gillenwaters, former Klamath county district attorney who is now executive officer of the air corps weather bureau, discussed the matter with Cornett on the latter's recent visit in Washington.

University Prepared Major Gillenwaters outlined the requirements and this information was conveyed to Governor Earl Snell by Senator Cornett. President Donald Erb of the University of Oregon then notified Major Gillenwaters that the university was prepared to meet the required qualifications.

Senator Cornett said this will mean the training of 200 students every six months.

DEALINGS TOP MILLION-SHARE FIGURE TODAY

NEW YORK, Dec. 29 (AP)—Irregularity continued in today's stock market as dealings topped the million-share figure for the seventh session this year.

The direction was downward from the start and, at the worst, decline ranged from fractions to a point or more. Quotations stiffened in many cases after mid-day and, in the final hour, modest advances were fairly well distributed.

Big blocks of low and medium-priced issues resulting from belated tax adjustments put the day's volume around 1,400,000
