COURT REVERSES PENDERGAST CHARGE

WASHINGTON, Jan. 4 (AP)—
The supreme court reversed to-
day the conviction of Thomas J.
Pendergast, former democratic
boss at Kansas City, Mo., and
two others on a charge of crim-
inal contempt of court in con-
nection with Missouri's \$10,000-
000 fire insurance settlement.

Justice Douglas delivered the
6 to 1 opinion, which also ap-
pealed to Robert Emmett O'Mal-
ley, former Missouri superin-
tendent of insurance, and A. L.
McCormack, St. Louis insurance
agent. Justice Jackson dissented
and Justice Murphy did not par-
ticipate.

They were accused of "fraud-
ulently foisting upon" a three-
judge federal court at Kansas
City "a corrupt settlement of in-
surance rate litigation, procured
through bribery on the Missouri
superintendent of insurance."

Validity of the conviction was
challenged on the ground that
the alleged activities did not
take place "in the presence of
the court or so near thereto as
to obstruct the administration of
justice." This was necessary, it
was contended, before the
judges could punish summarily
for contempt without the formal-
ity of an indictment and jury
trial.
