

LUMBER ASKS GOVERNMENT COOPERATION

TACOMA, Jan. 30 (AP) — The lumber industry lacks about 10,000 good loggers and the only way to settle the "debate over lumber production" is for the government "to cooperate with industry" in finding a way to get them, Wilson Compton, secretary of the National Lumber Manufacturers association, told the annual meeting of the West Coast Lumbermen's association here yesterday.

Compton said the national need for the coming year was \$2 billion feet and added "I think the lumber industry has ample capacity and sufficient equipment to produce the needed lumber, but what it lacks is about 10,000 good loggers."

Officers Named
Western Log and Lumber Administrator Fred H. Brundage told the association the next six months would see heavier demand for airplane grade lumber with "30 million feet of Noble fir alone required."

Orville W. Miller, Wauna, Ore., was reelected president. Other officers elected were C. H. Krenbaum, Shelton, and C. T. Gerlinger, Portland, state presidents; Judd Greeman, Verona, Ore., treasurer, and W. B. Greeley, Seattle, secretary-manager.

Shipwrecks Are What Really Worry Astoria Fisherman

ASTORIA, Jan. 30 (AP) — Bombs and torpedoes have caused John Niemi, onetime Astoria fisherman, no grief in three years' voyaging on merchant ships, but he can't say as much for shipwrecks.

The 25-year-old steward has been in three of them, the last on a coral reef in the South seas. A battered American cruiser, just out of the battle of Guadalcanal, rescued the crew. "No one was very excited over the wreck," he said, "but we were a bit jittery when sharks, attracted by the food supplies we were salvaging, gathered around."

Any attempt to destroy labor's gains will meet the united resistance of the CIO and AFL. International Vice-president Douglas A. Anderson of the CIO textile workers predicted at Portland... Many up-state towns have plentiful meat supplies in contrast to the bare shelves of Portland markets, said Mason B. Swift, Portland

manager of Swift & company. Clatsop county milk distributors offered to pay producers 90 cents a pound for butterfat, 10 cents more than the present price but 10 cents under the producers' demand... The Albany city council approved salary boosts from \$10 to \$20 monthly for city employees and brought the pay of department heads to \$180 monthly... U. S. Attorney

Carl Donough at Portland said his office is preferring charges of selective service violations against 19 men.

Medford reported a scarcity of pork, attributed by Meat Dealer Con Devore to shipments to Portland and San Francisco where prices are a half-cent to a cent a pound more than the local ceiling price of 15 cents... The AFL boltermakers at Portland announced granting of charters to a local at Vancouver, Wash., and a special auxiliary for negro workers.

COLLEGE RESERVE INDUCTION TOLD

WASHINGTON, Jan. 30 (AP) — The war department made public today details of its plan to induct most of the enlisted reservists in colleges at the end of the current semester.

Medical, pre-medical and engineering students in the enlisted reserve will not be called to active duty until the conclusion of the first semester beginning in 1943.

Students in the reserve officers training corps, who are members of the enlisted reserve corps, will be placed upon active duty as soon as the army specialized training is started at their school. Arrangements will be made for voluntary induction of ROTC students who are not members of the enlisted reserve.
