Army Starts New Recruit Drive; for Guns---Not Men

A short army recruiting campaign is being waged in Oregon through next Wednesday, February 24—but it is for shotguns, not for men.

The Army Ordnance Department wants 50,000 twelve gauge shotguns of the pump or automatic variety, and will pay up to \$50 for them.

The guns are wanted, according to T. A. Miller of the San Francisco Ordnance Depot, for guard duty in this country and to release rifles now used by the army on guard duty, such as at Japanese internment camps, to the combat forces. The shotguns, Miller says, have been found to be superior weapons for guard duty, especially at night.

Stores and agents of the Western Auto Supply have been named by Miller as receiving depots for the shotguns, and owners of 12-gauge pump or automatic shotguns who are willing to sell them to the government, should take them to any Western Auto Supply store or dealer through next Wednesday. The gun will be appraised by the dealer and if the price is satisfactory, the owner will be given a receipt for it and the money will be available at the store in a short time.

Double barrel and single shotguns are not wanted and neither are guns of any other gauge than 12.
