

KLAMATH JOINS V-HOME DRIVE WITH OREGON

Klamath Falls has joined Oregon's V-Home campaign and is holding "Civilians for Victory Week," starting Friday. A definition of what constitutes a V-Home is as follows:

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1. A V-Home is a protected home that has on hand all the materials and information neces-

sary for taking care of itself in the event we are attacked by enemy bombers.

2. A V-Home conserves. It doesn't buy things that it doesn't need; it takes care of what it has; and it raises as much food for itself as it can in a Victory garden.

3. A V-Home salvages. It saves its fats for glycerin and explosives; it saves and prepares its old tin cans for regular collection; it turns in all the old rubber and metals that it can.

4. A V-Home is a home that doesn't talk out of turn. It doesn't gossip and relay enemy propaganda, nor does it disclose information to anybody that would be useful to the enemy if it reached him.

5. A V-Home buys bonds and the 10 per cent payroll deduction plan is only a start. The V-Home of Oregon must buy \$100,-

000,000 worth of war bonds this month, which is \$100 for every man, woman and child in the state.

Local block leaders headed by Mrs. Jean Puckett, block leader council chief, and air raid wardens under the leadership of Colman O'Loughlin, will on Friday start the inspection of Klamath homes. Homes that pass the above listed requirements will receive a V-Home sticker for their window. The inspections are entirely voluntary. Anyone who doesn't wish his home inspected to try for a sticker is not required to have it done.

Those Klamath homes who are under the neighborhood leader plan and who feel they are qualified for a V-Home sticker should notify their local leader, and the sticker will be mailed to them.

MATHILDE SCHATZ DIES SUDDENLY

Spectacular Rescue Saves Marshal Foch's Grandson

ALLIED HEADQUARTERS IN NORTH AFRICA, April 27 (AP)—A grandson of Marshal Foch, allied commander-in-chief in the closing month of the first World war, was saved from death by an RAF pilot, it was disclosed authoritatively today.

The grandson, Captain Becourt Foch, who now is an RAF pilot, was wounded seriously by a cannon shell exploding in his cockpit but he managed to crash-land his plane. Weak from loss of blood, he certainly would have died had not a companion pilot landed beside him in enemy territory and taken him aboard his own plane, it was said.

Capt. Foch was flown to his

home field and then to Cairo where his life was saved by several transfusions. He has recovered and is flying again with the British.

Cheesemen Seek Point Reduction

PLYMOUTH, Wis., April 27 (AP)—George L. Mooney, executive secretary of the Wisconsin Cheesemakers association, said today the association would seek a sharp reduction of the ration points for cheese.

"Retail sales of cheese are practically at a standstill," Mooney said, "because of its

high ration point value. We believe the government should reduce the point values drastically."

Secretary Sees Milk Rationing

NEW YORK, April 27 (AP)—Merrill C. Maughan, executive secretary of the American Dry Milk institute, said today he believed all milk and milk products, including fresh milk delivered at the door, would be rationed, "probably next fall."
