Notice of School Election Upon Question of Increasing Tax Levy Over Amount Limited by Section 11, Article XI, State Constitution

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election will be held in School District No. 1 of Klamath County, State of Oregon, at the Fremont School, located at 715 High Street, Klamath Falls, Oregon, in said School District No. 1, on the 31st day of May, 1943, from the hour of two o'clock p. m. to the hour of seven o'clock p. m., for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said School District No. 1, the question, (1) of increasing the tax levy for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of July, 1943, and ending on the 30th day of June, 1944, over the amount limited by Section 11, Article XI, of the Constitution of Oregon, and (2) the adoption of the following proposed budget of estimated expenditures for said School District No. 1 for said fiscal year.

The reasons for increasing such levy are: 1. Increased cost of instruction 2. Increased cost of operation 3. Increased cost of maintenance and repairs

The amount of tax in excess of the 6% limitation, proposed to be levied for said fiscal year is \$47,166.99. Dated at Klamath Falls, Oregon, this 24th day of May, 1943.
