

DEADLINE FOR COOKERS NOW ON JUNE 25

The deadline for receiving applications for the purchase of victory model pressure cookers has been extended to June 25, it was announced by the county farm machinery rationing committee.

A quota of 120 of these pressure cookers has been announced for Klamath county. This represents an increase over the number formerly expected. Burrell Short, chairman of the farm machinery rationing committee, feels that it would be possible under this increased quota to issue certificates to families who show a large amount of use where less than six families will use the cooker.

Anyone desiring to purchase one of these cookers for canning vegetables and meats may secure an application blank from their dealer or from the county farm machinery rationing committee in the federal building.

5 PER CENT CUT IN PAPER TALKED

WASHINGTON, June 17 (AP) A 5 per cent cut in newspaper circulation appeared possible today.

The war production board's (WPB) newspaper industry advisory committee was called to a meeting here at which it was expected such a reduction in the paper used by the nation's newspapers—perhaps effective July 1—would be considered.

Last December the WPB issued a general limitation order, No. L-240, which the agency's printing and publishing division said was expected to result in a saving of 10 per cent in newspaper consumption in the United States.

But, the WPB said, only about half of that expected saving has been achieved in the first 5½ months of 1943. An additional 5 per cent—if agreed upon by the industry committee—would thus bring the total reduction to the 10 per cent figure expected by last winter's order.

At the same time, according to indications of the American Newspaper Publishers' association, it might be found necessary to reduce the newspapers' present inventory limit of 75 days to 30.

ANPA said that at the end of May publishers' stocks of paper were estimated at 30 days' supply, well under the inventory limit on the average.

70th Division at Adair Activated

CAMP ADAIR, June 17 (AP)—The 70th division, given the monicker "Oregon Trailblazers" and the traditions of the old 91st, has been activated here under the command of Brig. Gen. John E. Dahlquist, who was a deputy chief of staff for General Eisenhower in England.

Much of the cadre for the 70th was taken from the reactivated 91st, now at Camp White near Medford, Dahlquist said at the activation ceremony. He pointed out that the new division's staff officers were assembled at Fort Leavenworth, starting point for the Old Oregon Trail. Dahlquist formerly commanded the 70th infantry division.
