## BUYING SOARS WITH BETTER WAR REPORTS

NEW YORK, June 30 (AP)—Encouraging events on the war front generated a selective buying interest in today's stock market in which air transports, chemicals, and specialties achieved the best gains.

Steels, motors, aircrafts and rails failed to make the grade although some of these registered minor gains. In the favored departments advances ranged from fractions to more than a point near the close. Transactions totaled around 900,000 shares.

Strength in commodities supported inflationary ideas in Wall street.

Widest advances were registered by Eastern Airlines, American Airlines, Pan American Airways, Schenley Distillers, Morrosi and Essex, Montgomery Ward, Dow Chemical, Du Pont, Allied Chemical, J. C. Penney, and DeVoe and Reynolds.

Also on the up side were Consolidated Edison, Public Service of N. J., Montgomery Ward, General Electric, Westinghouse and U. S. Rubber.

Rails were slightly ahead in the bond market.

### WHEAT

**CHICAGO, June 30 (AP)—A** broad buying movement developed in grains today and prices of wheat and rye spurted about 2 cents, while oats gained about a cent. Mills and commercial interests were active in the wheat pit, sending quotations to the highest level since early April. With commission houses and local traders on the buying side, rye advanced to new peaks since 1937. Profit taking was heavy at times, but was surmounted without difficulty. Oats were at new seasonal tops.

Wheat closed 14-21c higher, July \$1.461-2, September \$1.461-1, oats were up 1-11c, July 69 1/2c, and rye was ahead 21-21 cents.
