registration period, answered "no" to the loyalty question, or failed to answer that question or to register. This is by far the largest group.

The members of the latter group will be given hearings to determine why they answered negatively to the loyalty question or failed to answer. These hearings will start in early August, and will probably continue for several weeks before the segregation is complete.

Coverley said there are from 4000 to 4500 in the Tulelake camp who are potentially eligible for detention in the center under the segregation. Most of these are evacuees who failed to register or answered negatively to the loyalty question.

It is believed here that the decision of the WRA probably means that the Tulelake center will be continued until after the war. Centers where loyal Japanese are held might conceivably be closed as these evacuees go out into private employment, etc., in non-defense areas.

Coverley said he could not at present estimate the number of disloyal Japanese which will be concentrated at Tulelake.
