The course is to begin on Monday, August 2, and will be held two or three nights each week. At the first meeting it will be decided by the students and the instructors how many hours and nights each week classes will be held.

After 72 hours, the applicants will be given a chance to obtain positions in different garages.

Rod Smith will be head instructor and mechanics from other garages will take charge of different departments.

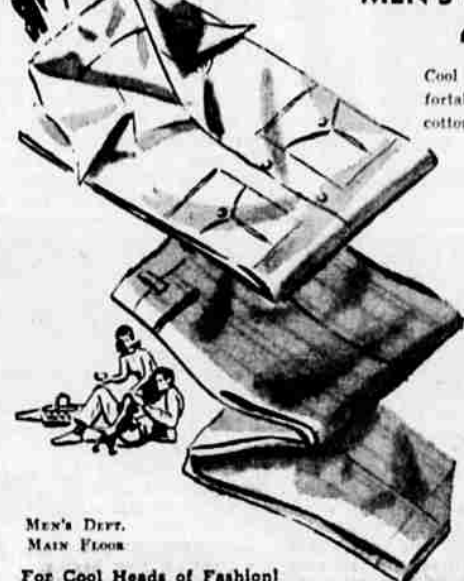
