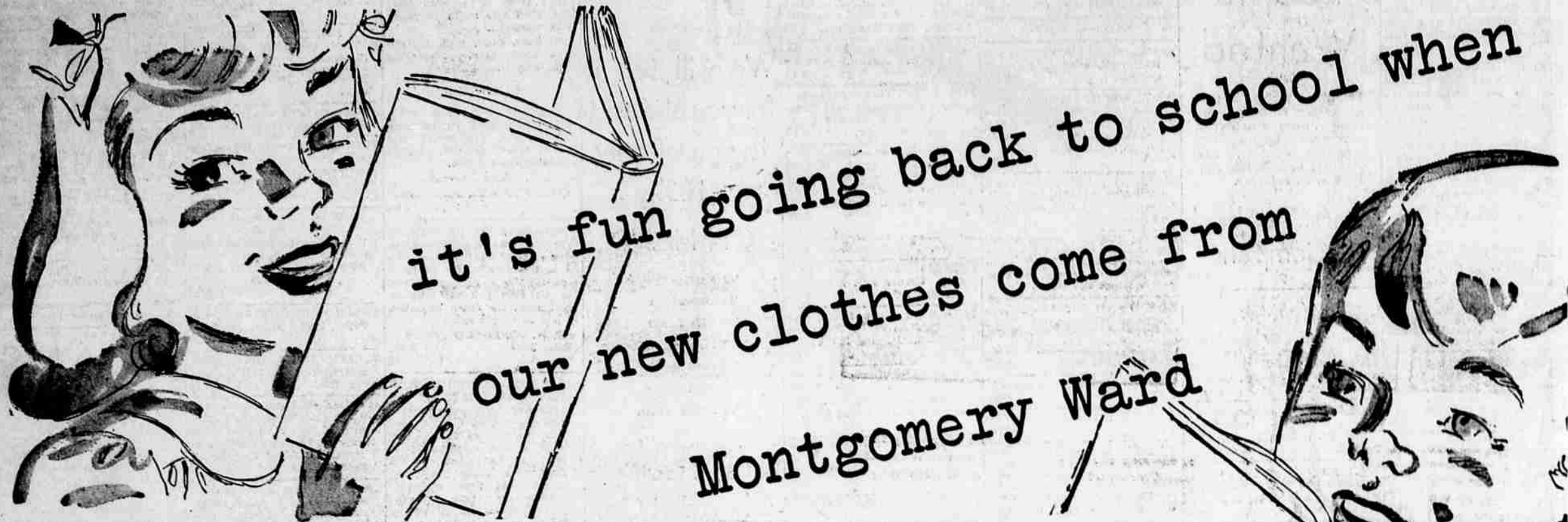
boats remained in Gibraltar harbor while an American tanker, carrying 14 planes on its decks, entered the port, the advices said.
