

LONDON ASKS NEW POLICY FOR FOOD

KANSAS CITY, Sept. 1 (AP)—Alf M. Landon, criticizing the national administration's food policy as one which "decided this week what it thinks it will need next week," asked Tuesday for a "realistic, continuous program" visualizing the place of American agriculture in the world economy.

"We need an intelligent program balancing livestock numbers with feed, encouraging rather than hampering the farmer," the 1936 republican presidential nominee said in an address for delivery at the Kansas City Cooperative club.

"That requires one sympathetic authority instead of many agencies working at cross-purposes."

State to Furnish 60 Per Cent of Welfare Funds

Effective September 1 and to be continued until further notice, the State Public Welfare commission will furnish 60 per cent of the funds used in Klamath county for general assistance, it was learned in a letter to the county court Tuesday.

Prior to this new ruling, the state paid 50 per cent and county the other 50 per cent. Now the county will only have to furnish 40 per cent, lessening the amount that the county has to raise for general assistance by approximately \$2000 per year.

Less Butter For Army Requirements; More for Civilians

NEW YORK, Sept. 1 (AP)—The new office of the war food administration reported Tuesday a departmental order from Washington announced that September military butter requirements had been cut 10 per cent and advised that no butter need be set aside for military purposes in October.

This was expected to result in an increase in the butter supply available for civilian consumption.

Currie Appointed Director for OEW

WASHINGTON, Sept. 1 (AP)—Laughlin Currie, administrative assistant to President Roosevelt, was named executive director of the office of economic warfare Tuesday in a shakeup which retired two key hold-over officials from Vice President Wallace's regime.

Leo T. Crowley, who took over direction of economic warfare in mid-July as an outgrowth of a public dispute over stockpiling between Wallace, chairman of the predecessor board of economic warfare, and Commerce Secretary Jesse Jones, announced Currie's appointment.

D. Hile, Giese denied he had specifically requested the return of pictures of Hitler "undamaged." The pictures are included in 334 exhibits which the government plans to offer as evidence.
