

EIGHTH ARMY JOINS FIFTH AT SALERNO

troop movements indicated the Germans were beginning to withdraw from the front facing the southern part of the bridgehead.)

Capture Town
Announcement of the contact was made by allied headquarters shortly after a communique had told of Montgomery's capture of Vallo Della Lucania, only 16 miles from Agropoli, at the southern end of the 27-mile front held by the fifth army.

At the same time Clark's army struck out from its hard-won shoreline and recaptured the mountain villa of Albanella, 10 miles inland, smashed three German counterattacks and flattened out several German salients that had been driven into allied positions.

Repulse Nazis
(An Alger broadcast by NBC said Montecorvino, 81 miles inland and 11 miles east of Salerno at the northern end of the bridgehead, also was captured in the repulse of one of the German attacks.)

(London dispatches said seizure of Montecorvino would be one of the more significant allied victories as the town is understood to be the site of one of the best airfields along the whole lower stretch of Italian west coast. With an airfield in allied hands there the scope and effectiveness of fighter plane protection for Gen. Clark's base of operations would be greatly extended.)

Germany Weaker
Gen. Eisenhower's communique said the Germans' efforts to reduce the allied bridgehead "have weakened considerably," that air and naval support of the land fighters continued to be heavy and effective, and repeated Gen. Clark's declaration of yesterday that the Salerno position was now "firmly established."

A headquarters spokesman, summarizing the two-week campaign that began with Gen. Montgomery's landing on the Italian toe September 3, said the allies now have occupied three entire provinces of southern Italy, grabbed the three valuable ports of Taranto, Brindisi and Bari, and gained possession of a large number of excellent air bases, particularly in Apulia province where there are paved runways on which the heaviest bombers can operate at all times.

Casualties
Two casualties — ambulance cases—arrived at St. Vincent's hospital in a police radio car. Neither of these civilian workers, Oscar Valignette, 33, and R. B. O'Brian, 35, was seriously hurt.

Valignette said he was working on the third floor of the administration building and glass from a nearby window cut his head. O'Brian, who was in another building, was cut about the head with flying debris.

Witnesses said the steel sides of a building near the damaged hangar were stove in by the force of the blast.

Baruch Warns of Slackening Plane Production in West

WASHINGTON, Sept. 17 (AP) A warning by Bernard M. Baruch that unless airplane plant labor forces can be increased on the west coast "we will fall short of the present aircraft production program for 1943 at a time when the military need for aircraft is greatest" was laid before congress today.

In a lengthy report placed in the congressional record by Senator Vandenberg (R-Mich), Baruch recommended to his chief, War Mobilization Director James F. Byrnes, that manpower control activities among government agencies be synchronized.

Police Nab Youth Driving Stolen Car

State police last night arrested a 15-year-old Portland boy in a 1935 Ford coach stolen yesterday morning in Portland. The youth was picked up at 7:20 o'clock at the Pelican City junction of highway 97.
