Klamath's bumper potato crop is the largest acreage yet. You know about the shortage of farm help. You know the part that food is playing toward winning the war. The cold, hard facts of the case are that unless every able bodied Klamath citizen will volunteer to help in the potato harvest in his or her spare time, these unsacked potatoes may lay on the ground to freeze.

That doesn't mean that anyone will have to quit his job or let some other vital work go. But it does mean that any person who has one day

or two days, or a week's vacation, will have to spend it in the potato fields to save the crop. Farmers have volunteered to provide transportation from town to the fields. It's squarely up to you ... it's your patriotic duty.
