

RENO, Nev., Sept. 29 (AP)—Fourteen of the 15 men who bailed out of a huge army air transport command cargo plane before it crashed near Lovelock, Nev., late last night have been reported safe and accounted for. The Reno army air base announced today, while a ground and air searching parties were securing the rough country for the missing flier.

The base republic relations office said the name of the missing flier will be withheld indefinitely.
