

AMERICAN WRITER INJURED IN CRASH

LONDON, May 25 (AP) — Ernest Hemingway, widely-known American writer, suffered head injuries in an automobile accident here last night but after a minor operation hospital authorities said today he was in no apparent danger.

A surgeon at St. George's hospital found upon cleaning and stitching a head wound that there was no fracture and that outside of the head injuries Hemingway was unhurt.

Hemingway, who arrived in London about a week ago as a correspondent for Collier's magazine, was hurt when the car in which he was riding with a British physician struck a static water tank.

The bearded writer's wife, Martha Gellhorn, also of Collier's staff, was expected to arrive in Britain shortly from the Mediterranean theater.

Hemingway is the author of numerous best sellers, including "The Sun Also Rises," "Farewell to Arms," "Death in the Afternoon," "The Green Hills of Africa," and "For Whom the Bell Tolls," which recently was made into a motion picture in the United States.

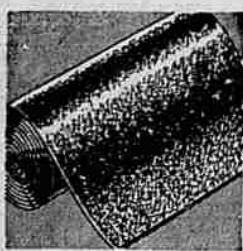
