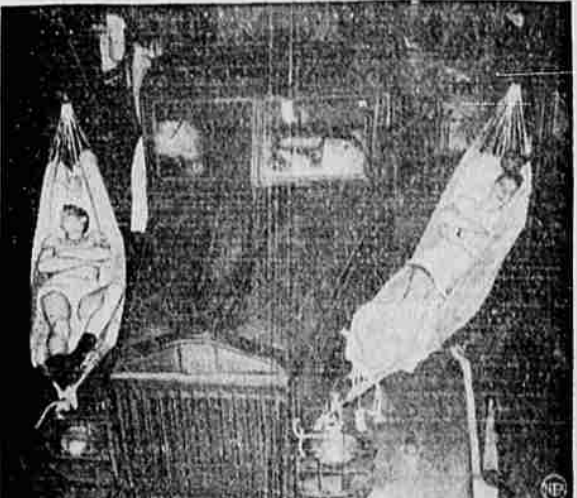


In Dad's Footsteps?

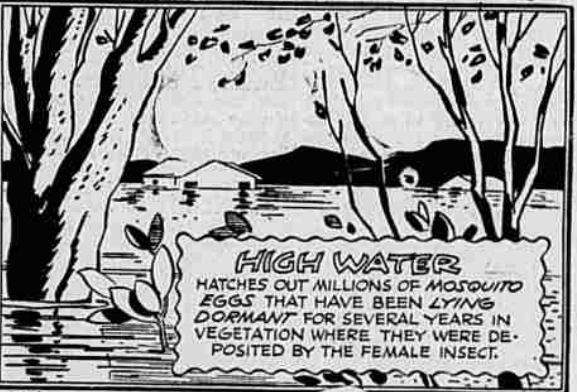

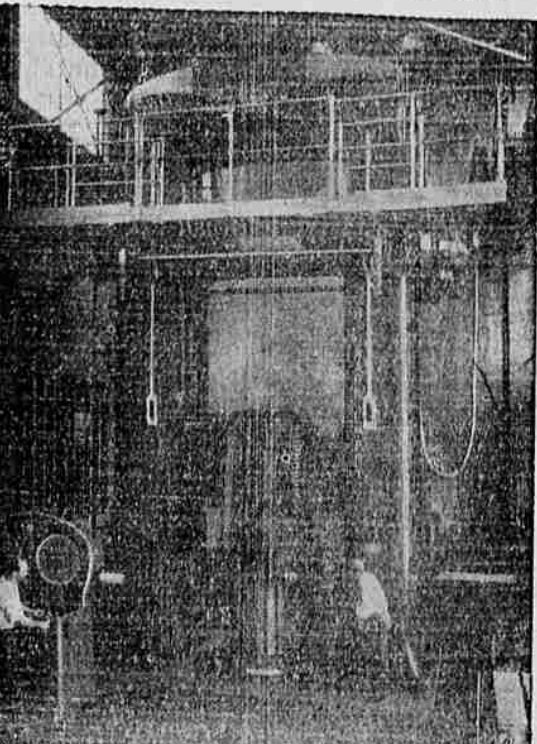
