Nationals Out for Win In All-Star Contest

Nationals Lean On Walters, Heavy Hitting to Break Losing Streak

By JACK HAND - Associated Press Sports Writer PITTSBURGH, July 11 (AP)—All-star baseball swings around the Major League wheel to Pittsburgh for the first time tonight with Billy Southworth leading heavily on Cincinnati's Bucky Walters and striking lineup with a 307 batting bulge to keep the National league's three-year losing streak from becoming a habit.

Manager Joe McCarthy of the Americans is expected to call on a Yankee battery of Hank Borowy and Rolie Hemslay to start the junior circuit's search for its ninth victory in the 12-game series.

A sell-out crowd of nearly 40,000 is predicted with fair and cooler weather. Both skippers delayed their arrival until the morning of the game after announcing lineups sprinkled with lefthanded hitters.

Behind Walters, Southworth is expected to come in with Nate Andrews of the Braves and Rip Sewell of the Pirates. All other National hurlers saw action as starters or relief men Sunday and would be working with only one-day rest.

EFFICIENCY OF FLYING BOMBS TOLD

SUPREME HEADQUARTERS ALLIED EXPEDITIONARY FORCE, July 11 (AP)—Gen. Eisenhower declared today that Germany's flying bomb in its present stage was not a very effective weapon except for attacks on sprawling metropolitan areas like London.

The supreme allied commander said in an interview that with in the reasonable future, there was little prospect that the weapon would improve in efficiency.

Discussing the "damnable thing" at an advanced command post, Eisenhower conceded that no one was taking lightly the experience which London and southern England are undergoing.

The bomb is one of those things on which the military must keep quiet for the moment, Eisenhower said, "but that doesn't mean I am not sympathetic to the people who are having to suffer from the damned things."

"I am just as concerned as anybody else about finding ways and means of getting them down and preventing them from becoming more serious."

Eisenhower said the allies have been successful in keeping the weapons down, to a certain extent. Scientists still must evolve something more effective than the defense measures now in use, he said.

From the Germans' point of view, the flying bombs give him a cheap air force, the commander said, "even his attacks are wild. They jetison bombs all the way from Landis to Dover. The flying bomb is just as effective—and a damned sight cheaper."
