APPEAL BOARD TO MEET AT WRA CENTER

The first session of the board of appeals to hear cases where application for leave clearance have been denied by the director of the war relocation authority, will be held at the Tulelake segregation center on July 28, it was announced today.

Chief Justice James H. Wolfe, of the supreme court of the state of Utah, and Bruce Bartley, prominent attorney of Seattle, Washington, will constitute the board to hear the cases. Neither of these men are in any way connected with the war relocation authority, except as temporary members of the board of appeals.

Individuals who have been denied leave or the right to relocate outside of a WRA center, have the right under WRA regulations to file an appeal. They may appear in their own behalf before the board and be represented by counsel. The board will review all previous evidence in each case and have available transcripts of any previous hearings given.

Only persons who have previously been denied clearance by the director of the war relocation authority and are residents of the Tulelake segregation center, may apply for review of their cases by the board of appeals.

Yank Seamen Must Get Passports

WASHINGTON, July 13 (AP)—Effective November 15, American seamen will not be able to ship out of the United States for a foreign port without a passport.

By August 15, the state department announced today, seamen must have either a passport or evidence that they have applied for one within the preceding six months.

The order was issued by the secretary of state "in order that the interest of the United States and its merchant marine may be safeguarded by every possible means."

The department also said the regulation meets legal requirements that all Americans leaving the country have passports. Seamen had been excepted to expedite the wartime shipping program.
