

ALUMINUM AUTHORIZED BY WPP

WASHINGTON, July 18 (AP)—The Aluminum Association has authorized the use of aluminum for manufacturing of aircraft parts and pans in the first of a series of articles intended to put into effect the program of War Production Administration Chairman Donald Nelson for the reconversion of industry to war production.

The program, which has been approved by the War Relocation Authority, provides for the substitution of aluminum for other metals in aircraft parts and pans. It does not, however, restrict the production of any other metal.

The program also permits use of aluminum as a substitute for other metals, but there are no restrictions on the use of aluminum in the production of other metals. The program is being continued in effect principally to prevent the loss of labor from war production.
