Bernard Shaw, 88 Today, Sees No Lasting Peace

(George Bernard Shaw, known variously as one of the world's great literary figures, as leader of a cult who disdains cults, called the "literary bad boy" and "professional Irishman" who is accused of taking an entirely orthodox delight in unorthodoxy, is 88 years old today. Asked for his views on certain post-war problems, the reply which follows verifies that time dulls neither the edge of his tongue nor his ideas, which brought bitter condemnation upon him in World War I. 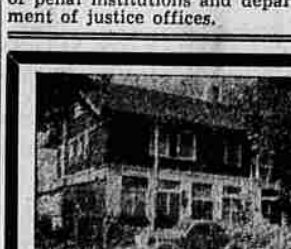

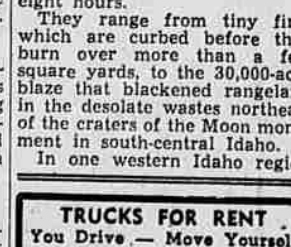
