STANDARD COMPANY TO HANDLE CANOL

WHITEHORSE, Y. T., Aug. 3 (CP)—Standard Oil company of Alaska, with headquarters at Whitehorse, now is operating and will continue to operate and maintain the Canol refinery and the pipeline system between Whitehorse, Norman Wells, N. W. T., and points in Alaska and northwest Canada, it was announced today by the northwest service command.

The firm also will be responsible for maintenance of the pipeline across road from the wells to the refinery.

When the Canol project first was planned by the United States war department early in 1942, the Standard Oil company of California was requested by the war department to operate and maintain the pipeline and refinery facilities on completion. The company undertook the assignment on a non-profit basis as a contribution to the war effort, and contracts were entered into. Sole objective of this company is to operate the Canol project as contractor to the U. S. war department.
