Farm Labor Wage, Supply Problems Being Worked Out

Important developments in farm labor supply and wage problems for the Tulelake and Lower Klamath districts...

These include the establishment of harvest wages for basin grain harvests, supply of Mexican and prisoner war labor...

At a meeting of grain growers with representatives of the extension service and Tulelake Growers, the following grain harvest wage scale was agreed upon:

Head tenders, \$8 a day and board. Jiggers and cart men, \$8 and board. Sack sewers, truck drivers, cat men, \$10 and board.

These wages are based on an average 11-hour day. It was agreed on a charge of \$1.50 a day for board for laborers not working.

MINERAL OIL KILLS CORN EAR WORMS

In victory gardens large enough to allow sweet corn plantings there will be need to protect the growing ears from the corn earworm...

The corn earworm is the principal insect enemy of sweet corn. The larvae (or worms) hatching from eggs usually laid on the silks...

Use an ordinary glass medicine dropper that holds about 20 drops when half full, enough for a small ear...

Wait at least three days after the silk first emerges before oiling. By that time the silks should be wilted and the tips beginning to turn brown...

FEED TO AVOID SUMMER MILK SLUMP

Too little feed is the principal cause of the rapid decline in milk flow in the early summer... By the time the cows begin to get thin and milk flow drops off noticeably, it is too late to bring it back by heavier feeding...

The 8 Point Program 1. Grow more legume hay, pasturage, and grain. 2. Fertilize to increase quantity and quality of feed.

3. Feed to avoid summer milk slump. 4. Feed cows liberally during their dry period. 5. Keep as many cows as feed and labor permit. 6. Market more whole milk whenever possible.

7. Produce good-quality milk and avoid waste. 8. Breed for better herd replacement.
