

DEWEY SLATES HEAVY FIGHT FOR BALLOTS

Klamath Falls, Sept. 15 (P) — The campaign which Dewey would not interfere with in the slightest was outlined today by Thomas E. Dewey as he conferred with Montana Gov. Ford and other political leaders.

The torchlight parade for the first time in his country campaign, Dewey said, will be a "torchlight parade" when a crowd estimated at 7,000 persons will march from the republican nominee's arrival here from Sherburne, N. Y., to the station platform in the glaring white light of the torches, the New York governor promised the cheering throng that "we will have a torchlight parade from now until the end of the campaign."

Speaking at a theme he first developed when he was welcomed home after his return from the Chicago Republican convention, Dewey said that by winning an election at this time American people were demonstrating in perhaps a most effective way that free men can win a war.

AVERAGE SPUD YIELD, GOOD QUALITY SEEN

Average yield and good quality are in evidence in the potato fields of the Klamath basin, it was reported today by County Agent C. A. Henderson after a quick survey Thursday.

Henderson said that in view of growing conditions, the quality is better than had been expected.

This week's frosts have generally stopped vine growth, and many vines are frosted down. Potatoes in the ground, however, are still putting on weight in some fields.

Shipments have already picked up to between 40 and 50 carloads a day. A majority of the spuds are going to the customary San Francisco markets, but a few carloads have gone to Portland and Seattle. There has been some eastern inquiry that indicates some Klamath spuds may go east this year, according to one shipper.

The September ceiling price is \$2.45 per hundredweight on No. 1 potatoes. In October, the price will drop to \$2.30. Size A prices are 10 cents higher.

General price levels for No. 1 spuds paid here are right on the ceiling, it was reported.

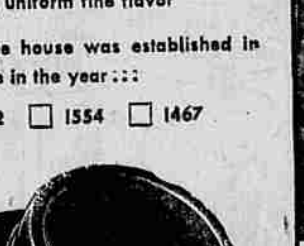
