"Mickey" Cochrane To See Active Duty

GREAT LAKES, Ill., Sept. 15 (AP)—Lt. Cmdr. Gordon (Mickey) Cochrane, whose baseball teams at Great Lakes for three seasons won recognition as national service champions, is to leave next week for active duty in the southwest Pacific.

Cochrane, former Philadelphia Athletics catcher and later manager of the Detroit Tigers, entered the navy in April, 1942, and was assigned to the center as baseball coach. In the off season he was regimental commander in recruit training.

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Pettigrew Winner On Opening Day of Pendleton Roundup

PENDLETON, Sept. 15 (AP)—Homer Pettigrew, of Grady, N. M., who was all-around cowboy champion in 1941, took first place in the calf roping and bulldogging events at the opening day of the 33rd Pendleton Round-Up yesterday.

Trouble Hits Washington Grid Eleven

Trouble, in the shape of the first fall announcement of the list of restrictions on V-12 and naval ROTC men because of low grades, hit Coach Ralph Welch's University of Washington football team a hard blow today.

When a name turns up on a restriction list, the owner becomes ineligible for athletic competition for 30 days, a period which now will cover the Huskies' four games with Willamette and Whitman. These four lads will be lost to the team.

There was a possibility one of the four might receive a hearing, as only one point in his scholastic standing in a single subject caused his upset. The new standards are higher than Coast conference eligibility rules, and none would be ineligible under those.

Dick Ottele, Long Beach, Calif., a civilian, loomed as probable quarterback to succeed Zech.
