ALLIES LAND ON ADRIATIC; BLOCK NAZIS

action made use of the Albanian coastal road so precarious for the Germans that "the enemy was forced to send supplies to other garrisons by small sea-going craft," the announcement said.

Generally, in the past, Adriatic land force operations have been of a Commando type, involving relatively small numbers of troops. Along Entire Coast The German radio said the landings were made "from Albania along the whole Dalmatian coast," which lies to the north in Yugoslavia. Another broadcast from Berlin by the official news agency DNB said "Strong naval and air forces attacked the island groups off the Dalmatian coast "on a broad front," and that fighting continued.

Between the advancing Russians in the northeast and the allied forces on the coast, the Germans faced prospects of a march through a mountainous country dotted by partisan forces, both Albanian and Yugoslav.

The Germans have been reported massing along the Greek frontiers of Yugoslavia and Albania, preparatory to a trek back toward the reich. Those who have crossed the borders have been attacked by the partisans.

to Klamath Valley hospital, and city police placed a mattress on the floor of the party wagon and took Hixon to Hillside. Amputation Necessary McPherren's physician said that his condition was such that immediate surgery was impossible. McPherren's left leg was virtually severed below the knee. The right leg was crushed. McPherren received a bad laceration of the right cheek where the impact hurled him against the radiator cap on Young's car. Hixon was standing to the left of McPherren in such a position that only his right leg was caught between the two bumpers. His physician said that he was suffering from shock in addition to a fractured right leg.

Caught Between Bumpers According to witnesses, Hixon had driven up to the Sixth Street Exchange and was showing McPherren a tent in the rear compartment. It was then that Young's car crashed into the two, catching them between the bumpers.

City police said Young told them that he recalled parking and steering toward the curb at 6th and Plum but that was all. He said he did not remember seeing the two men standing at the rear of the other car.

The setback, at the hands of furious German counterattacks that ringed off the gallant division and prevented the British second army's land drive from achieving a junction in rescuing force, lost a gamble to win quickly a crossing of the upper Rhine for a flanking drive into Germany around the upper end of the Siegfried line.

Germans Retreat In Latvian Area

MOSCOW, Sept. 27 (AP)—The German retreat to Riga was turned into a desperate stampede today by swiftly pursuing red army armor and infantry which had cleared northern Latvia to within 20 miles of the Baltic seaport. North and east of Riga the enemy was making no attempt to hold an organized line but the overland escape corridor westward from the city along the coast in the direction of East Prussia was being kept open regardless of losses, front dispatches said.

On the southern end of the eastern front the Russians appeared to be concentrating new pressure on Hungary. Although nothing was said officially concerning Hungary, there seemed reason to believe the combined Russian and Romanian armies are battering at its borders and may already have crossed.

Northwest of Firenzuela, the Americans cracked enemy resistance and seized Monte Beni, 22 airline miles due south of Bologna. They also won the south slopes of nearby Monte Freddi, Casellaccia, two and one-half miles southwest of Monte Acuto and Monte Pratolungo, crossed by a trunk highway which passes through the mountains to Imola in the Po valley 15 miles away.
