PORTLAND LAWYER SEES OTHER SIDE

PORTLAND, Sept. 29 (AP)—Boon Cason, Portland attorney, resumed his law practice today with a new insight into the prisoner's viewpoint.

Cason retorted "just bunk!" to Municipal Judge A. E. Wheelock yesterday when the judge said a client's bail would be raised if the case were postponed. Wheelock, startled, asked Cason to repeat.

"Just bunk," said the attorney firmly.

"You're in contempt of court," ruled the judge. "Five days."

Cason climbed into the prisoner's box beside his client. "I've come close to jail before," he said, "but this is the first time I've ever had to sit behind bars, wondering how long five days would be."

He didn't find out, though. He was released later in the afternoon.

State Hospital, Prison Inspected

SALEM, Sept. 29 (AP)—The Marion county grand jury, after investigating the state hospital and state prison, found conditions generally good.

The jury, however, said that serious fire hazards exist in a male ward at the hospital, but this ward will be replaced after the war.

The jury recommended that the \$25 monthly charge which relatives pay for care of patients be used directly for the hospital's benefit. This money now goes into the state general fund.

SNAKE RIVER BOAT PARTY LATE, SAFE

LEWISTON, Idaho, Sept. 29 (AP)—Two days overdue in their boat trek down the hazardous Snake river Hell's Canyon, the four-man party is nonetheless safe, Amos Burg, Portland explorer and group leader, reported by telephone last night.

Burg, telephoning from 80 miles upriver, said rough rapids caused the delay. They had had no accidents, he reported.

Two members of the party, anxious to complete the trip, will be flown out today by plane from Pittsburgh Landing, where the planes must use a pasture for a landing field. These men are Charles H. Wheeler, San Francisco, past president of Ro-

tary International, and Alexander Patterson, Seattle.

Burg and Dr. Wendell G. Frazier, Bingham Canyon, Utah, will continue the trip by boat and expect to reach here Saturday.

The party left Huntington, Ore., September 19 in two rubber boats and a wooden craft.
