neers said today. And what women want isn't performance, but appearance, William S. James told the Ore-gon meeting of the society. "The public, to the automobile maker, is women," he said. "If the wo-men don't like it, the poor hus-bands have a tough time." James, chief engineer of an automobile manufacturing firm, predicted a postwar automobile

predicted a postwar automobile differing only slightly from 1942 designs. War production, except for technical manufacturing methods, has not developed improvements applicable to peace-time vehicles, he said.
