

BOCKMIER IN U. S. AFTER INTERNMENT

Mrs. Earl Whitlock returned this week from Spokane, Wash., where she was the guest of her son-in-law and daughter, Lt. Lt. and Mrs. Ralph Bockmier Jr., and their young sons.

Lt. Bockmier was returned to this country a short time ago, following his internment in Romania. He was shot down over Romania and reported missing May 7. Three men were killed in his bomber. While young Bockmier was attempting to land his parachute, he was captured and held in custody for two days. At the

end of that time he was moved to Bucharest where he was held until the removal of American airmen by plane in September. Bockmier was on the first plane which left Bucharest for Italy, in what made one of the most sensational stories of the war.

During the airmen's internment he suffered from attacks of diphtheria and neuritis, in addition to wounds received while in the air. Bockmier wears the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Purple Heart. He leaves soon for Monterey for further assignment. Mrs. Bockmier is the former Dawn Everett of this city.
