War Price and Rationing Board, 430 Main Street, Office hours daily, 9:30 a. m. to 4:30 p. m.; Saturday, 9:30 a. m. to 2 p. m., Phone 8161 for all information.

All applications must be MAILED in to the War Price and Rationing Board at 430 Main Street, and NOT presented in person.

SUGAR—Ration book 4—Sugar stamps 20 through 33 valid indefinitely, 3 pounds each. Sugar stamp 40 valid through Feb. 28, 1945 for 5 pounds home canning only. For more canning sugar, apply local board using spare stamp 37.

PROCESSED FOODS—

BLUE STAMPS—ration book 4—A through Z8 and A5 through W5 valid indefinitely.

MEAT, BUTTER, CHEESE—

RED STAMPS—ration book 4—A8 through Z4 and A5 through P5 good indefinitely.

GASOLINE—"A" 15 gallons December 21. Each coupon worth 4 gallons. Coupons not valid unless endorsed "B" or "C" coupons may be renewed within, but not before 15 days from date on cover of book.

FUEL OIL—Period 4-3 coupons and new period coupons valid through August 31, 1945. Not more than 7% of season's rations should be used to date.

STOVES—Apply local board for purchase certificate.

SHOES—Book 3 airplane stamps 1-2-3 valid indefinitely.

RENT CONTROL—All rental property must be registered by November 15.

PRICE CONTROL—Refer inquiries and complaints to price clerk at local board.

RENT CONTROL—All rental dwellings must be registered by landlords before November 15.
