Roadside Planting of Trees Planned

SEATTLE, Nov. 15 (AP)—In full approval of the "evergreen playground" for future tourist traffic, the West Coast Lumbermen's association announced last night that a half million seedlings of Port Orford cedar and Douglas fir from the stock of the Forest Industries tree nursery at Nisqually, Wash., have been earmarked for free supply to special school and roadside forest planting projects.

The association cited as an example of roadside improvement, the project begun last winter along the Wolf Creek highway in Oregon from Portland to the coast. Work will continue this year with extensions to the Wilson Creek highway, both highways running through lands ravaged by fires in 1933.

INCREASE PREDICTED

CHICAGO, Nov. 15 (AP)—Wheat was strong but other grain futures markets were unsettled today, rallying after an opening break only to fluctuate over a fairly wide range the remainder of the session.

The strength of the wheat market reflected a scarcity of offerings and refusal of traders to press the selling side while government price support measures are in force.

Corn rallied sharply after hitting a new low for the season with the deferred contracts showing greater strength.

Wheat covering by local traders near the close disclosed a scarcity of offerings in the 17c pit and prices rallied steadily.
