Removal of Names Likened to German Action On Jewish

PORTLAND, Dec. 18 (AP)—A University of Oregon faculty member has likened the removal of Japanese-American soldiers' names from the Hood River county war memorial to the scratching of Jewish soldiers' names from German World War I honor rolls a few years ago.

"Americans, then, called the German action typically Nazi," declared Dr. Harold J. Noble at a club meeting here. Dr. Noble, former marine officer, said he had been under fire with Japanese-Americans frequently and found them loyal, courageous and devoted to duty.

BULGAR-Ration book 4-Sugar stamps 30 through 32 valid indefinitely, 3 stamps each. Sugar stamp 43 valid through Feb. 28, 1947. No other home rationing only. Stamp 34 valid November 8 indefinitely.

PROCESSED FOODS-BLUE STAMPS ration book 4-A through 28 and A3 through W3 valid indefinitely. NY23 and A2 and B2 valid December 1, indefinitely.

MEAT BUTTER-CHEESE-RED STAMPS ration book 4-A through 28 and A3 through W3 valid indefinitely. Q155 valid December 2, indefinitely.

GASOLINE-"A" 13 expires December 31, 1945. "B" and "C" coupons not valid unless endorsed. "B" or "C" coupons may be renewed within, but not before, 15 days from date on cover of book.

FUEL OIL-Period 4-5 coupons and new period 1 coupons valid through August 31, 1945. Not more than 75¢ of season's rations should be used to date.

STOVES-Apply local board for purchase certificates. SHIRTS-Book 3 airplane stamps 1-2-3 valid indefinitely.

Pope to Celebrate Christmas Eve Mass

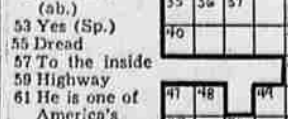
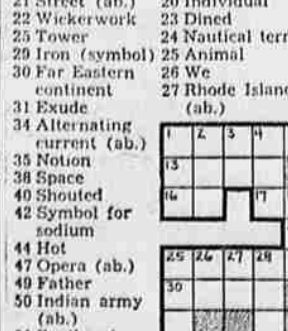
