NEW YORK, Dec. 22 (P)—It was an earth-shaking, once-in-alifetime feat, but Ernic Lombardi, molasses-footed catcher for the New York Giants, did NOT contribute 1944's No. 1 sports oddity the day he beat out an infield hit against the Boston Braves.


