PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 23 (AP) Test drilling for oil in Oregon's Columbia county may begin soon.

Carl G. Kinney, general manager of Clark-Wilson Lumber company, disclosed that his firm has leased Columbia county logged-over timber land to the Texas company, an oil corporation.

The Texas company has established an office here following geological tests in Columbia county and other western Oregon areas. Geologists have claimed that oil deposits underlie Oregon land, although previous tests have ended in dry holes.

WHITE ROSE SPUDS SORTED, TAGGED

The only certified seed potatoes that are being sorted and tagged at the present time are White Rose, according to J. R. McCambridge, assistant county agent.

These potatoes are moving into the early spud producing areas in California, McCambridge said. As yet no certified Gems have been sorted or tagged and there are a number of good lots of seed in Klamath county.

Growers who desire certified seed for commercial or seed production should contact seed producers early and procure their seeds for 1945, stated McCambridge. If there is no demand shown for this seed, the growers will consequently be forced to put their seed on the commercial market, he concluded.

MARINES, SAILOR DECORATED HERE

Two marines and one sailor received the Purple Heart at the Marine Barracks Saturday morning, and Sgt. Tallbot Vogler, holder of the Bronze Star, was formally presented with his permanent citation by Col. George A. Van Orden.

The awards were made during a review of troops on the parade grounds with Capt. W. W. Curtis serving as commander of troops with Lt. W. L. O'Brien as adjutant. Two companies of marines took part in the ceremony.

PFC Paul M. Witte, PFC Michael Perakovic, and PFC 3/c Nickolas J. Ellen, were the men who received the Purple Heart for wounds received in action. Witte received shrapnel wounds in the arm and leg, while serving on Guam. Perakovic was wounded in the foot by mortar shell fragments on Saipan, and Ellen was struck in the hand by a Jap bullet and in the knee by shell fragments, also on Saipan.

Vogler was decorated last August. His temporary citation, from Admiral Nimitz, commended him for work as a stretcher bearer on Bougainville.
