Renew Attacks

Twenty-three Japanese planes renewed their attacks on Mindoro installations. Eight were shot down. Eleven others were destroyed in U. S. sweeps over the Philippines and the Moluccas to the south.

Mitchell b o m b er s raiding Lingayen gulf north of Manila for the first time damaged a large Japanese freighter-transport. Other allied planes left six small freighters sinking off Borneo.

Pravda Says Japs Suffering Defeats

MOSCOW, Dec. 30 (P)—Pravda, describing Japan as Hitler's last ally, said today she had been suffering "continuous defeat on land, sea and air in the Pacific."

The article, spread over five columns, appeared to be the most significant soviet utterance about the orient since Marshall Stalin's November speech classifying Japan as an aggressive nation.

"Development of Pacific events becomes ever more unfa-vorable for Japan," said the ar-ticle by G. Zhukov, Pravda staff political writer.

"Continuous defeat in the war with Britain and the United States has sharply worsened eco-nomic and especially food condi-tions inside Japan."
